

## Aspiring White Allies of Ohio

### Statement in Honor and Remembrance of Breonna Taylor

In remembrance of her birthday, the Aspiring White Allies subcommittee (AWA) of the Anti-Oppression Committee (AOC) stand in solidarity with the family of Breonna Taylor, who was murdered by Louisville Metro Police on March 13<sup>th</sup>.

Members of the AWA have responded to Breonna's family's requests for action, as recommended by "Take Action & Fight for Breonna" and listed below. We encourage others to do the same.

#### In Her Mother's Words

"Breonna, she was a great person. You don't like to call people perfect, but she really was perfect. She did everything right as trying to be a kid coming into an adult life. She loved to help people, she loved to be around family. She loved life and she was just figuring hers out. She was just getting started."

**Step 1:** Visit [Justice for Breonna](#). Read her story, listen to her family.

**Step 2:** Click the "Take Action" button. This will take you to a site with action steps confirmed by Breonna's family, and **a request not to add demands they have not confirmed.**

**Step 3:** Follow the recommended steps therein, including these from the site:

- "Engage in the recommended actions, which include **POST about Breonna**, using the hashtags #BreonnaTaylor and #JusticeForBre. Her story has yet to receive the national attention it must to cause local systems to respond. **Share her story, images of her smiling face, and tag the responsible parties. On Twitter, use @LMPD, @LouisvilleMayor, and @GovAndyBeshear. On Instagram, use @LMPD.ky, @MayorGregFischer, and @GovAndyBeshear.** We cannot stop until she receives a response.

**Notes on Making calls & sending emails:**

As noted on materials provided by justiceforbreonna.org, please do not make demands not listed. The AWA recommends visiting [this Google Doc](#) for updates on action steps and contacts before engaging in this action step.

“Speak and/or write clearly that you make the following demands on behalf of Breonna Taylor & her family:

1. Demand the Mayor and City Council address the **use of force** by LMPD.
2. **Fire and revoke the pensions** of the officers that murdered Breonna. Arrest, charge, and convict them for this crime. Ensure the newly requested **special prosecutor**, State AG Daniel Cameron, seeks **full transparency and accountability**.
3. Provide all necessary information to a **local, independent** civilian community police accountability council #CPAC.



4. Create **policy for transparent investigation** process due to law enforcement misconduct.
5. **DEMAND MET** **Drop all charges for Kenneth Walker**, Breonna's boyfriend, who attempted to defend them and their home.
6. **DEMAND MET** **Release the 911 call** to the public for accountability.
