The ideal candidate is comfortable teaching people with intellectual and developmental disabilities about sexuality, healthy relationships, safety, and self-defense and is familiar with the various systems that surround people with cognitive disabilities.

- Manages the *IMPACT: Ability* program. Teaches *IMPACT: Ability* to groups of adults and teens with developmental disabilities.
- Provides educational supports in safety, healthy relationships, sexuality education to adults and teens with intellectual disabilities
